



Calculating discount prices in retail

Your store has discounted a range of items for stock clearance. Complete each label to show the saving and the new sale price.

Tip: Round up original prices to the nearest pound. Then subtract the percentage discount from the original price.



Example: 25 percent off £39.99. Round up to £40.00 and divide by 4 = £10.00. £39.99 (original price) minus £10.00 (discount) = £29.99 (sale price)
