4. The world record for the most rainfall in 24 hours is 1,825mm. If this amount of rain fell for 2 days in a row, what would the total rainfall be, in centimetres?
5. Outside Hafsa's window is an icicle 19cm in length. If 8cm melts, how long will it be?
6. One winter day, the temperature is -2°C . If it gets 3°C colder, what will the temperature be?
7. If 2.5 inches of rain falls each month for 5 months, how much rain is this in total?
8. In June it was sunny for 15 days. In July it was sunny for 12 days. In August it was sunny for 5 days. How many sunny days is that in total?
9. Each day has 24 hours. In July the sun shines for 16 hours then sets. How many hours in a day is there NO sun?

3. Craig is tracking the depth of snowfall in his garden. Today it's 7cm deep. If an extra 2.5cm falls overnight, how deep will it be? = **9.5cm**
4. The world record for the most rainfall in 24 hours is 1,825mm. If this amount of rain fell for 2 days in a row, what would the total rainfall be, in centimetres? = **365cm**
5. Outside Hafsa's window is an icicle 19cm in length. If 8cm melts, how long will it be? = **11cm**
6. One winter day, the temperature is -2°C . If it gets 3°C colder, what will the temperature be? = **-5°C**
7. If 2.5 inches of rain falls each month for 5 months, how much rain is this in total? = **12.5 inches**
8. In June it was sunny for 15 days. In July it was sunny for 12 days. In August it was sunny for 5 days. How many sunny days is that in total? = **32**
9. Each day has 24 hours. In July the sun shines for 16 hours then sets. How many hours in a day is there NO sun? = **8**
10. There are 21 trees in a park, but a storm knocks down a third of them. How many trees are left standing? = **14**
