

1. As the pupils enter

Have the webpage open and play your chosen music.

2. Introduction

Ask: What is your favourite lesson in school? [Gather responses and point out how different everyone's favourite is.] Now imagine that you only got to do maths, all day every day, and never got to have a go at doing something different. Would it get boring? [Gather responses].

In our school we have a 'diverse curriculum' - which means learning about lots of different things and having a wide variety of activities. This makes school much more interesting. We also have diversity in the types of people there are in the world - different heights, different hair colour, different likes and dislikes - and that diversity of people and cultures makes life more interesting too. Now we're going to atch a short video about diversity...

3. Play the video

The duration is 3' 54". Final words: '...variety is good for all of us.'

4 & 5. Time to talk

Ask pupils to spend a few moments thinking about the ways in which they are different from the people next to them.

Can you think of a friend that has been able to teach you something new, because they come from a different place or speak a different language?

You could ask some of the questions asked on the film:

- Have you ever been treated differently?
- What could you do if someone was being treated badly because they were different in some way?
- Is our community welcoming to all people, like the community of the girl in the film?

6. Opportunity to sing

If the assembly is to include a song you could sing it now.

7. Opportunity to reflect

Ask pupils to think about all the things that make them who they are: their looks, their strengths, their religion, their family and their culture.

You might be similar to other people in our school community, or you might be very different, but we are all welcome and we are all part of a wonderful, diverse world.
