



Hello again - I'm Nigel - and welcome to today's workshop on our musical version of **Macbeth**. Our song today is called 'Killing ground' - it's a rap for Malcolm's army as they march on Dunsinane, seeking revenge on Macbeth. It's quite short and shouldn't take as long to learn...so if you've got time today you could even go straight on to our last song – the 'Finale'. Have a listen.

As you heard, the only sung part is the chorus, which consists of two phrases, both to the same tune.

In case you're wondering, 'a 'harbinger of death' is a 'bringer of death'. This time, as I sing the tune, try to draw the shape of the tune, with your hands held out in front of you. Here we go.

The first few notes are the same, then it goes down then up again - and, of course, the second phrase does exactly the same. This time as you listen to the chorus tap the beat on your knee. Then be ready to sing the chorus back immediately after, when I count you in.

If you look at the words to the verse you'll see that some have been underlined - these are the ones to emphasise or accent, just like you accented certain words in our other raps. So now let's learn Verse 1, beginning 'We're coming Macbeth...' which goes like this:

We're going to learn all four lines of the first verse now. After you hear line 1, repeat it straight away. Then the same with lines 2, 3 and 4. Let's practise to begin, with the first line only. Listen first and tap your knee on the beat like you did earlier.

Okay. Let's go on to the last verse now. Follow the words from 'Live by the sword...'

Well done everyone! You're ready to rap 'Killing ground' all the way through - with just the backing track if you're feeling really confident. Make sure you stand up when you do - to give the rap maximum energy - and if you like you could try dividing into two groups to rap either alternate lines or perhaps alternate verses.
