CARRIE OK! Now before we sing the whole verse I should tell you about the

introduction. You'll hear a thunderclap and then this sound –







MUSIC FALLING CHROMATIC SCALE

CARRIE The music moves down one semitone at a time. That's called 'chromatic'.

It's very quick and dramatic, creating tension and painting a picture of the

ship rolling about in the storm. That descending section is also your signal

to prepare to sing. So take your breath right after it.

CARRIE You've learned most of the song so I'd like to focus on the end where

there's an instrumental based on the 'down, down, down, rhythm. You can join in using your own instruments, but let's clap it out first. Half the class should clap the 'down, down, down' rhythm – which you'll hear on drums –

like this:

MUSIC DRUMS

CARRIE Followed by the other half stamping the two notes in response – like this:

MUSIC STAMPS

CARRIE You try it now. If you think the words 'down, down, down' as you clap the

first three notes that should help you. 1, 2, 3, 4...

SONG down, down, down

CARRIE To do the whole instrumental you play that rhythm four times with a silent

bar between each. Then after the fourth time, without waiting, everyone plays 'down, down'. Clap again, or use instruments like drums and symbols...or even metal buckets or dustbin lids. Whatever you can

find! Here we go from the last line of the song...
