DAVID Hello everyone. David Grant here again and today we're going to learn the final song in Heroes of Troy. Yes, this is the finale, simply called 'Heroes.' This is going to be a busy 20 minutes because doesn't that sound like a fantastic song to learn! And if you're anything like me you'll also be desperate to hear the end of the story: does the horse work, that's what I want to know! Let's get straight into a vocal warm up. We'll use one you know already: 'Na, na, na, na, na.' Stand up! We'll start with 'Na'...

ALL **Na, na, na, na, na.**

DAVID 'Ha'...

ALL **Ha, ha, ha, ha, ha.**

DAVID 'Du'...

DAVID 'Yo'...

ALL **Yo, yo, yo, yo, yo.**

DAVID 'Aye'...

ALL **Aye, aye, aye, aye, aye.**

DAVID One more time starting with 'Na' on this note: 'Na'. Are you ready?

ALL **Na, na, na, na, na.**

DAVID 'Hey'...

ALL **Hey, hey, hey, hey, hey.**

DAVID 'Du'...

ALL **Du, du, du, du, du.**

DAVID 'Yeah'...

ALL **Yeah, yeah, yeah, yeah, yeah.**

DAVID 'Ha'...

ALL **Ha, ha, ha, ha, ha.**

DAVID 'Yo'...

ALL **Yo, yo, yo, yo, yo.**

DAVID 'Aye'...

ALL **Aye, aye, aye, aye, aye.**

DAVID One more warm-up before we learn the finale. It's this one, do you remember?

SONG *Paris and Ulysses they are a few of the Ancient Greeks.*
Hector and Achilles fought in a battle of Ancient Greeks.

DAVID Okay! Straight in. Sing it right through going up a key each time. Here's your intro. Ready, 2, 3, 4:

ALL Paris and Ulysses they are a few of the Ancient Greeks.

DAVID And up, and:

ALL Hector and Achilles fought in a battle of Ancient Greeks.

DAVID 3, 4:

ALL Paris and Ulysses they are a few of the Ancient Greeks.

DAVID And up, and:

DAVID Going up, and:

ALL Paris and Ulysses they are a few of the Ancient Greeks.

DAVID Once more:

ALL Hector and Achilles fought in a battle of Ancient Greeks.

DAVID Right! We'll learn the finale a little bit at a time and, for a change, we'll start with the chorus.

- SONG *We are the heroes of the ancient world,

- DAVID Okay, now listen to the first line and sing it right back after I count you in. Listen:
- SONG *We are the heroes of the ancient world,*
- DAVID Your turn. 1, 2, 3, 4, 1:
- ALL **We are the heroes of the ancient world,****
- DAVID Now the next line. Listen first!
- SONG *The super heroes of the ancient world.*
- DAVID Now you sing along. 3, 4, 1:
- ALL **The super heroes of the ancient world.****
- DAVID We going to sing both lines now. 3, 4, 1:
- ALL **We are the heroes of the ancient world,****
- DAVID Now the super heroes line. 3, 4, 1:

- DAVID Just once more to be sure. 3, 4, 1:
- ALL **We are the heroes of the ancient world,****
- DAVID 3, 4, 1:

- DAVID It continues like this. Listen:

- SONG *You might think you're man enough*
But you don't wanna mess with us.
Who do you think you are?

- DAVID Listen to the first bit again and sing it back straight away. Here we go. Listen:

- ALL** **You might think you're man enough**
But you don't wanna to mess with us.
- DAVID And listen!
- SONG *Who do you think you are?*

- DAVID Your turn to sing. 1, 2, 3, 4, 1:
- ALL** **Who do you think you are?**
Heroes of Troy!
- DAVID Right! Let's do it all together now from 'You might think you're man enough.' Are you ready? 2, 3, 4:

ALL **You might think you're man enough**
But you don't wanna to mess with us.
Who do you think you are?
Heroes of Troy!

DAVID Okay! Let's recap the whole chorus from 'We are the heroes.' Ready?
2, 3, 4, 1:

ALL **We are the heroes of the ancient world,**

DAVID 2, 3, 4, 1:

ALL **The super heroes of the ancient world.**

DAVID 'You might think you're man enough.' 3, 4:

ALL **You might think you're man enough**
But you don't wanna to mess with us.
Who do you think you are?
Heroes of Troy!

DAVID Well, that's the chorus. Let's learn the rest now. Here's how the first
bit goes. Listen carefully:

SONG *In those far off days of old,*
The bravest in the land.
Tales of daring deeds are told,
Let me take you by the hand.

DAVID Did you notice that the tune in the second half is almost the same as the tune in the first half? Listen again and this time sing the first phrase back after me. Listen first.

SONG *In those far off days of old,*

DAVID Ready? 1, 2:

ALL In those far off days of old,

DAVID Now listen!

SONG *The bravest in the land.*

DAVID And 3, 4:

ALL The bravest in the land.

DAVID Both these phrases together now after the count. 1, 2:

DAVID 3, 4:

DAVID Listen on!

SONG *Tales of daring deeds are told,*

DAVID You sing. 1, 2:

ALL Tales of daring deeds are told,

DAVID And now...

SONG *Let me take you by the hand.*

DAVID And sing!

DAVID Back to the beginning and down to there, after the count. 1, 2:

ALL In those far off days of old,

DAVID Great! Let's try it from the top of the song now and after the verse go on to sing the chorus. Here's just a little bit of an intro to get you started. It's good isn't it? Anyway, I'll count you in at the beginning but then you're on your own. Okay? After 2...take a breath and really enjoy it. Deep breath...3, 4, 1, 2:

ALL In those far off days of old,

The bravest in the land.

Tales of daring deeds are told,

Let me take you by the hand.

It's all about destiny

And the rest is history.
