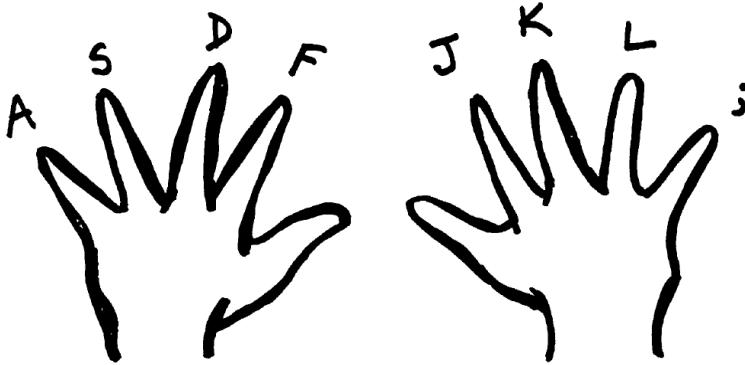




## Starting to type

Put your fingers on the home keys as shown in the diagram:




The little finger on your **left** hand should be on



The little finger on your **right** hand should be on



Find the space bar on the keyboard. This is the longest bar on the bottom row of the keyboard. Your thumbs should be resting on the space bar.

Use the 'enter' key  to move on to the next line. Press the 'enter' key with the little finger of your right hand at the end of each line. Try to keep your eyes on the copy, not on your fingers. It's a good idea to say each letter as you type it.

## Starting to type

Now try these exercises. Type the letters below. Press the space bar twice between each letter pattern. If you make a mistake, just type the letters again. Don't use the 'delete' key. When you get to the end of the line, press the 'enter' key to move on to the next line.
