



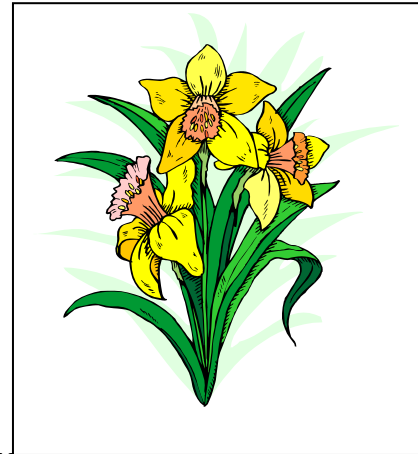
**Plural endings**
