



## Changing adverbs

The meaning of a sentence can be changed completely by using a different adverb. For example: 'The children were **smartly** dressed.' **And** 'The children were **scruffily** dressed.'

Look at the sentences below. **Have a go at changing the meaning of the sentences by using different adverbs:**

1. She smiled sweetly at the camera.

2. He walked quickly through the crowded streets.

3. I'm going outside for some peace and quiet.

I'm going \_\_\_\_\_ for some peace and quiet.

4. She always played roughly with her toys.

She always played \_\_\_\_\_ with her toys.

5. We were all extremely tired after the long journey.

We were all \_\_\_\_\_ tired after the long journey.

6. The burglar opened the window quietly.

The burglar opened the window \_\_\_\_\_ .

7. Rapidly boil the soup for 20 minutes.

\_\_\_\_\_ boil the soup for 20 minutes.

8. The woman laughed nervously at the policeman.

The woman laughed \_\_\_\_\_ at the policeman.

9. The man politely asked the other driver to move his car.

The man \_\_\_\_\_ asked the other driver to move his car.

10. She slurped her soup noisily.

She \_\_\_\_\_ slurped her soup.
