
Choosing books with children



Choose books together.

Look for authors and subjects that children like. Show them how to look in the book as well as at the cover.







Look for books with rhyming words and short repeated sentences.

These are easy for young children to read along with. Fairy tales are great for this.



Be prepared to read books over and over again.

This can be boring for adults – but is great for early readers.



✓ Let your child set the pace.

Don't try to move children on to harder or 'older' books before they are ready. If there are five or more words on a page that your child finds hard, the book may be too difficult.
