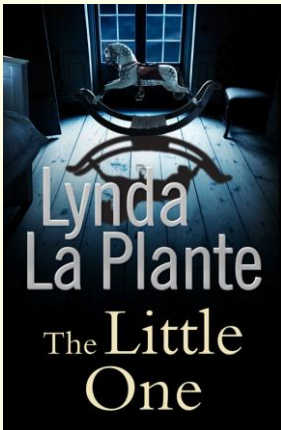




The Little One – Story development
