


Using a number line

Adding and subtracting


A number line can be used for adding and subtracting by counting on or back.



Working out change

Find change from £5 when you spend £3.75.


Count up in pence to the next £ then count up in £: total change = 25p + £1 = £1.25



Multiplication and division

Number lines can also be used for multiplication by repeated addition or division by repeated subtraction.

eg 48 ÷ 12 count back in 12s:



There are four 12s in 48

$$48 \div 12 = 4$$
