

## Understanding frozen-food packets

Jim has been shopping and needs help deciding where to store his food. He lives in a block of flats where he can use three different freezers or a fridge, which has an ice-making compartment, to store his food.

Read the descriptions next to Jim's shopping and decide where he should store the food.



**\*\*\* Freezer.** Food can be stored at  $-18^{\circ}\text{C}$  or below until the best before date.

Frozen prawns, which he'll eat within one month.



A frozen pizza, which should be eaten within one week.



**\*\* Freezer.** Food can be stored at  $-12^{\circ}\text{C}$  for one month.



Fresh ham, which won't be frozen. It should be eaten within two days.



**\* Freezer.** Food can be stored at  $-6^{\circ}\text{C}$  for one week.



Frozen broccoli which should be eaten within eighteen months.

Frozen hamburgers, which he'll eat tomorrow.



A fresh chicken, which he wants to freeze and will eat within one month.



**Fridge ice-making compartment.** Frozen food can be stored at  $-6^{\circ}\text{C}$  for three days.

**Main part of fridge.** Food can be stored at  $5^{\circ}\text{C}$ .
