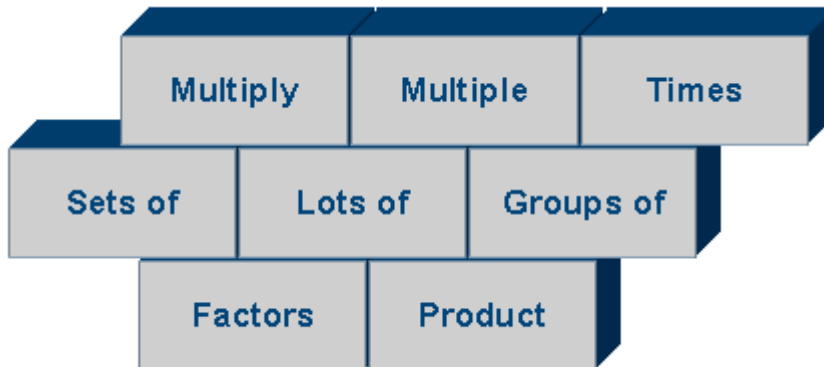


Multiplication glossary

Here are some of the words that will crop up when you do **multiplication** sums:



Have a look below to see how they can be used in the simple sum $2 \times 2 = 4$.

Factors

2 is a **factor** of 4. One number is a **factor** of another number if it divides or goes into it exactly.

Groups of

2 **groups of** 2 make 4.

Lots of

2 **lots of** 2 make 4.

Multiple

4 is a **multiple** of 2.

Multiply

If you **multiply** 2 by 2 you get 4.

Product

The **product** of 2 and 2 is 4.

Sets of

2 **sets of** 2 make 4.

Times

2 **times** 2 is 4.
