

## Rounding up

Use the **rounding up** method to multiply these amounts. Remember to **round one number to the nearest 10** and **adjust the answer**. For example:

**49 × 6 is the same as:**

$$50 \times 6 \text{ minus } 1 \times 6$$
$$300 - 6 = \mathbf{294}$$
