

Choosing the right option: add, subtract, multiply or divide

State whether you need to **add**, **subtract**, **multiply or divide** to find the answers to the following problems. (There's no need to solve them.)

- 1. Ciaran offers to buy some bottles of water for his students. The bottles of water cost 85p each. He has £8.50. How many bottles of water could he buy?
- 2. The time is 2.25 pm and Ruth needs to leave the house at 3.30 pm to meet a friend. How long does she have before she has to leave?
- Shannon bought the following items: Pizza £4.00 Bananas £0.42 Milk £0.88

How much did she spend altogether?

- 4. Julia bought 3 cartons of milk. Each carton cost 48p. How much did she spend on milk?
- 5. Carlos bought a jacket in a half-price sale. The jacket cost £34 originally. How much did he pay in the sale?
