

Fractions of a whole

What if you have a cake cut into six equal parts?



One slice is $\frac{1}{6}$ of the cake.



Five slices are $\frac{5}{6}$ of the cake.

But if it's too delicious to give away, then you would have $\frac{6}{6}$ of the cake!



If you put all six slices together they make the whole cake.

So $\frac{6}{6} = 1$.
