

Rounding money

The rules for rounding money are as follows:

Rounding to the nearest 10p:

If the amount ends in 5p or more, round up to the next 10p above.

If the amount ends in less than 5p, round down to the 10p below.

Rounding to the nearest £:

If the amount ends in 50p or more, round up to the next £ above.

If the amount ends in less than 50p round down to the £ below.



Round the food items in the Gainsby's bill to the nearest £ to get an idea of the total cost of the shopping:

£ 2.00
£ 1.00
£ 1.00
£ 2.00
£ 5.00
£ 1.00
£ 1.00
£ 2.00
£ 3.00
£ 1.00

The **approximate** cost of the shopping would be **£18.00**.

The **actual** cost is **£18.20**, so £19.00 would be a good estimate.
