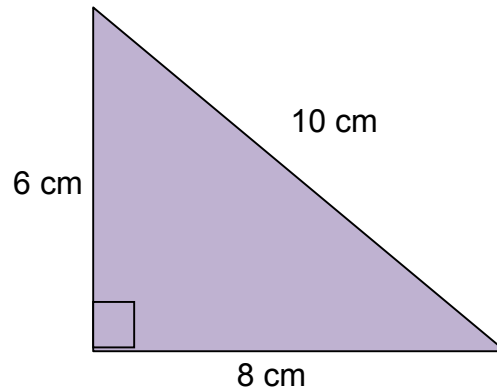




The perimeter of triangles

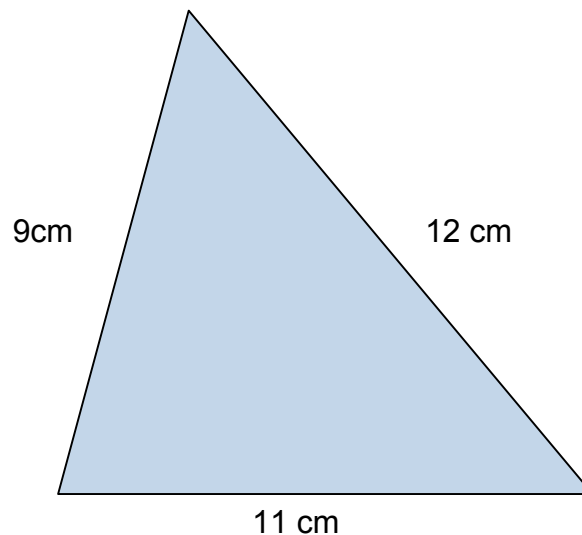
To find the perimeter of shapes **other than rectangles**, you need to make sure you go around the **outside** and include **all** the measurements.

Example 1



The perimeter of the right-angled triangle is $10\text{ cm} + 8\text{ cm} + 6\text{ cm} = \mathbf{24\text{ cm}}$

Example 2



The perimeter of the triangle is $11\text{ cm} + 12\text{ cm} + 9\text{ cm} = \mathbf{32\text{ cm}}$
