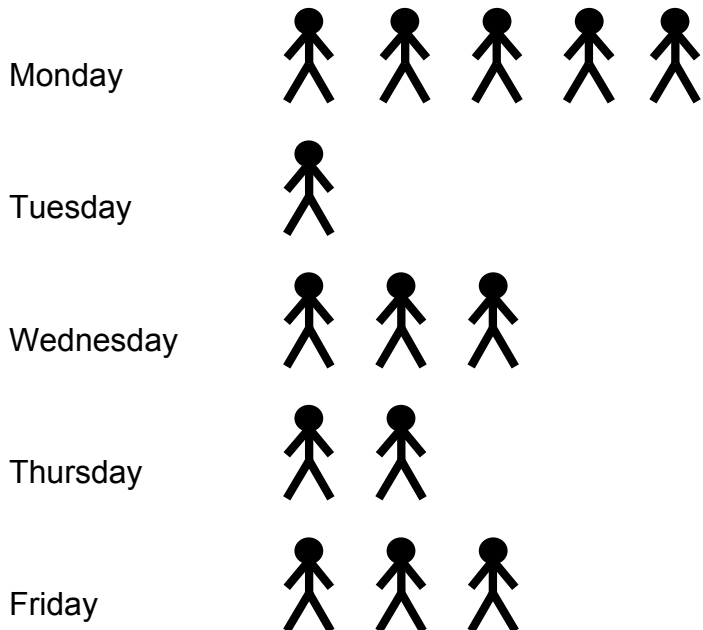




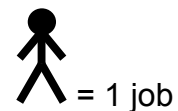
Organising and comparing data

4. Find the difference between the two numbers.
5. Next week the plumber does the following number of jobs:
Monday = 2, Tuesday = 3, Wednesday = 2, Thursday = 4, Friday = 5.
Put them in order from smallest to largest.
6. Find the difference between the largest and smallest number of jobs in that week.
7. Next week he does 3 jobs on Monday, 2 on Tuesday, 2 on Wednesday, 0 on Thursday and 5 on Friday. Find the difference between the largest and smallest number of jobs in that week.
