



## Using an index - answers

This is a page from an index.

1. What sort of book does this index come from?

Correct answer: the index comes from a gardening book.

2. If you wanted to check what grows well in the soil in your garden, what page would you turn to?

Correct answer: you would turn to page 11 for information about acid, alkaline and chalky soils.

3. If you were troubled with a disease on your roses, what page might be helpful?

Correct answer: you might turn first to the section on diseases on pages 79-84. If you knew that the disease that was affecting your roses was blackspot, you could go straight to page 79.

4. If you wanted to do some building work in your garden, what page might help you?

Correct answer: you could have a look at page 19, which will tell you about brickwork in the garden.

5. If you didn't have a garden, but wanted to grow something on your small patio, what page might be useful? .

Correct answer: you might want to look at the information on hanging baskets on pages 34-35.

6. If you wanted some spring colour in your garden, is there anything here that might give you some ideas?

Correct answer: You could look at the pages on bulbs, 39-41. Or you could go straight to particular bulbs, such as crocuses on page 40 or daffodils on page 41. You might even choose other plants.
