Wensday should be **Wednesday**, **tomatoe** should be **tomato** and **chocl**ate should be **chocolate**.

Also the writer has used **stake** instead of **steak**, **been** instead of **bean**, **place** instead of **plai**ce and **mo**ose instead of **mo**usse. These are all examples of mistakes using **homophones** - words that sound the same (or similar) but are spelled differently and have different meanings.

Proofreading a menu - answers

If you're using a word processor, the spellchecker will usually ignore this type of mistake - so take care!
