



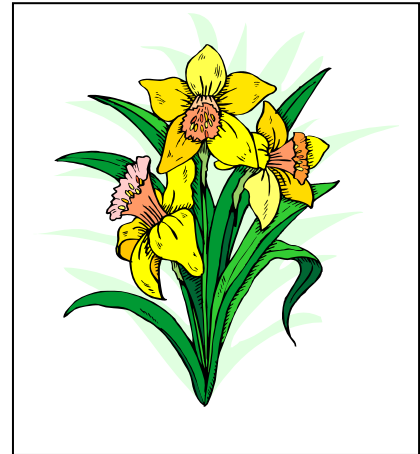
Plural endings - answers
