Correct answer: **False**

Correct answer: **False**

3. He says sometimes you have to listen 20 times to be able to appreciate the music, true or false?

Correct answer: **True**

4. He thinks digital and free music is more disposable, true or false?

Correct answer: **True**

5. He says people might only listen to digital music once or not at all, true or false?

Correct answer: **True**

6. He would like to see more independent record shops, true or false?

Correct answer: **True**

7. He doesn't like old-style records, true or false?

Correct answer: **False**

8. He doesn't like digital music because you can't hold it in your hand or look at a record sleeve, true or false?
