



Using a double number line - answers



- 1. Draw a double number line to help you convert between centimetres and metres, (remember 1 metre = 100 cms) and then use it to do the following conversions.
 - a. 4 metres = 400 cms
 - b. 9 metres = 900 cms
 - c. 200 cms = 2 metres
 - d. 700 cms = 7 metres
 - e. 350 cms = 3.5 metres
- 2. Use these double number lines showing equivalents between fractions, decimals and percentages to complete the conversion table below.



| fraction | decimal | percentage |
|----------|---------|------------|
| <u>3</u> | 0.3 | 30% |
| <u>5</u> | 0.5 | 50% |
| <u>8</u> | 0.8 | 80% |
| 9 10 | 0.9 | 90% |
| 1 10 | 0.1 | 10% |
| 4/10 | 0.4 | 40% |
