



## Examples of everyday and mathematical words - answers

Other examples could include:

- **prime**, which means the most important in the everyday and is a number with no divisors in mathematics
- product, which relates to items being bought and sold in the everyday and the result of multiplying in mathematics
- **right**, which means correct in the everyday and 90° in mathematics
- possible usually means 'possible but unlikely' in the everyday, whereas in mathematics it
  can span unlikely to certain eg we say it's possible to win in a raffle we usually don't
  expect it to happen
