Round both the numbers to 40 (39 + 1, 39 + 1), 40 × 2 = 80 80 - 2 = 78



£16 + £14


Add 2 to 14 to make 16 $16 \times 2 = 32$, then take the 2 away





£131 + £129

Round both the numbers to 130 (131 - 1,129 + 1) $130 \times 2 = 260$ The -1 and +1 cancel each other out



699 + 710

Round both numbers to 700 (699 + 1,710 - 10) 700 × 2 = 1,400 1,400 - 1 + 10 = 1,409
