



Multiplying by 1,000 - answers

To multiply by 1,000 make the number bigger by moving all the digits along **three** places.

TTh = tens of thousands

Th = thousands

H = hundreds

T = tens

U = units

- $52 \times 1\,000 = \underline{\underline{52.000}}$
- $88 \times 1\,000 = \underline{\underline{88.000}}$
- $410 \times 1\,000 = \underline{\underline{410.000}}$
- $803 \times 1\,000 = \underline{\underline{803.000}}$
- $6.214 \times 1\,000 = \underline{\underline{6.214}}$
- $35.017 \times 1\,000 = \underline{\underline{35.017}}$
- $34.12 \times 1\,000 = \underline{\underline{34.120}}$
- $8.9 \times 1\,000 = \underline{\underline{8.900}}$
- $127.3 \times 1\,000 = \underline{\underline{127.300}}$
