

## Calculating bigger or smaller amounts - answers

1. If the cost of 5 rolls of camera film is £12.50, work out the cost of 8 rolls.

Correct answer: Divide by how many you know ( $\pounds 12.50 \div 5 = \pounds 2.50$ ) then multiply by what you want to know ( $\pounds 2.50 \times 8 = \pounds 20$ ). **The answer is \pounds 20**.

2. If the total cost of 15 tickets is £75, work out the cost of 8 tickets.

Correct answer: Divide by how many you know ( $\pounds$ 75 ÷ 15 =  $\pounds$ 5) then multiply by what you want to know ( $\pounds$ 5 × 8 =  $\pounds$ 40). **The answer is \pounds40**.

3. A recipe for flapjacks needs 60 g of oats and it makes 10 flapjacks. What quantity of oats is needed to make 24 flapjacks?

Correct answer: Divide by how many you know (60 g  $\div$  10 = 6 g) then multiply by what you want to know (6 g × 24 = 144 g). **The answer is 144 g**.

4. This list of ingredients is enough to make oat cookies for 10 people. How much of each ingredient would you need for 3 people?

Correct answers:	For 10 people	Ingredients	For 3 people
	200 g	margarine	60 g
	10 drops	almond essence	3 drops
	10 tsp	golden syrup	3 tsp
	250 g	rolled oats	75 g
	100 g	brown sugar	30 g
	200 g	wholewheat flour	60 g
	1 tsp	baking powder	0.3 tsp

The method here is to **divide** each amount by 10, then **multiply** it by 3.
