In Britain we use a mixture of **imperial** and **metric measurements**. Have a go at placing the everyday measure items (at the bottom of the table) in the 'when used' columns below, using your understanding of measures used in the UK.

Weight

ounces	weight of steak on a restaurant menu	milligram	weight of gold
pounds	amount of dried fruit in a large wedding cake	gram	measure of medicine in tablet form
ton	weight of a truck	kilogram	weight of a baby born this year

Capacity

Imperial measure	When used	Metric measure	When used
fluid ounces	measure of wine by the glass	millilitre	measure of cough syrup
pints	ordering beer in a pub	centilitre	markings on a measuring jug
gallons	filling petrol	litre	filling petrol
