

Choosing units and instruments to measure weight - answers

Have a look at the following items. What would be the most suitable metric unit of measurement? What instrument would you use for measuring? Then have a go at estimating the measurement. The first one's been done for you.

| Object | Unit | Instrument | Estimated measurement |
|-------------------|-----------|-----------------|---|
| An orange | grams | kitchen scales | 200 g |
| Yourself | kilograms | bathroom scales | 65 kg (average weight of a woman in UK) |
| A bag of sugar | kilograms | kitchen scales | 1 kg |
| A can of beans | grams | kitchen scales | 420 g |
| A bag of potatoes | kilograms | kitchen scales | from 1 kg |
| A car | tonnes | weighbridge | from 1 tonne |
| A letter | grams | letter scales | 30 g |
| Luggage | kilograms | bathroom scales | 23 kg (luggage allowance) |
