

Bus timetables - answers

How did you do? Look at the Blackmore to Donnington and London Flyer timetables again to check these answers for yourself.

1. If you wanted to go to Brimmingham, which times would you avoid catching the 'London Flyer'?

Answer: 11.00, 13.00, 15.00 - the coach goes straight through Brimmingham.

2. If I caught the 10.40 bus from Grinsley, Church Lane to Donnerton, what time could I catch the connecting 'London Flyer' to travel to London?

Answer: **12.00** - the 10.40 bus would get me to Donnerton at 11.40 giving me 20 minutes until the next 'London Flyer' leaves.

3. I want to travel from Blackmore Market Place to London, to arrive before 4.00 pm. Which bus should I catch from Blackmore (opp hospital) and what time will I arrive in London?

Answer: I could catch the **09.20** bus, which would get me to Donnerton at 10.40. I could then catch the 11.00 'London Flyer' and get to London at **15.17** (3.17 pm).

OR, I could catch the **0820** bus, which would get me to Donnerton at 09.40. Then the 'London Flyer' at 10.00 will get me to London at **14.33** (just after half past 2). Both these journeys would get me to London before 4.00 pm.

4. My friend wants to travel from Boxley to Brimmingham on Saturday. She would like to leave after 11.30 am. Which is the best bus for her to catch from Boxley and when will she arrive at her destination?

Answer: She could catch the 11.55 bus from Boxley, but the connecting 'London Flyer' at 13.00 goes straight through Brimmingham (see the answer to question 1). It would be better to catch the **13.00** bus from Boxley and the **14.00** 'London Flyer'. She will arrive at Brimmingham at **16.18**.

5. My friend and I decide to have a trip to London. I live in Crostham and she lives in Brimmingham. Plan the journey to London for us, making sure we get the same 'London Flyer'.

Answer: I could catch the **09.15** bus from Crostham and the 'London Flyer' at **10.00**. My friend could get on the coach at **12.18** and we would be in London at **14.33**. There are more possible journeys. See if you can spot them with your tutor.
