1. Which months have an average temperature lower than 22°C?

February, March April and December

2. Do any months have both the same average highest temperature and the same average lowest temperature as each other? Name the months and list the temperatures?

April and December (high 31°, low 21°) May and November (high 31°, low 22°) June, July, September and October (high 32°, low 23°)

3. Which month or months have the smallest difference between their average highest and lowest temperature? What is the difference?

August 6°C

4. Suggest the type of people who might be interested in the information in this table.

Example: people visiting or intending to visit Jamaica.

- 5. If you were shown the same information for the UK what differences would you expect to see?
 - The average highest temperatures and average lowest temperatures would probably be lower.
 - There would be more difference between the summer and winter temperatures.
