


Interpreting a bar chart - answers

Suggested answer

You should have added a title and labels to your bar chart. Check to make sure that your bar chart is right by showing your work to someone who can help.

Here is an example of a possible answer, yours will be different:



This bar chart now makes sense because it has:

- a suitable title 'Driving tests taken at the West Heath Test Centre w/c 19th May'
- a named vertical axis 'Number of people'
- a named horizontal axis 'Day of the week'
- named vertical bars Monday to Friday
- a key to explain what each of the bars represent either pass or fail

If you can, discuss your ideas with someone who can check that your bar chart now makes sense.
