


Interpreting line graphs - answers

The **line graph** shows temperatures over the year in Jamaica.



- 1. Which month had the highest temperature? **August**
- 2. Which month had the lowest temperature? **February**
- 3. What is the difference in temperature between February and May? 3°C (32 29)
- 4. How many months have a temperature higher than 30°C?

Nine (all except January, February and March)

- 5. What is the range of temperatures in Jamaica over the year? 4°C (33 29)
- 6. Would you expect the temperature range in the UK to be similar or different? Explain your answer.

I would expect the temperature range in the UK to be much bigger as it is quite cold in winter and quite warm in summer. The average highest temperatures in the UK might range from about 8 - 23°C (a mathematical range of 15°).
