

ACTIVITY FOUR: PROMOTING EFFECTIVE INTERVIEWING TECHNIQUES

Pupils pick one celebrity and write down ten things they know about that person. The teacher poses the question- 'if we already know this and we've checked it's true- would it be worth asking the celebrity the same things?' (The answers being no!)

Pupils decide on the things that they don't know about the celebrity and then construct questions, adopting the techniques covered in the lessons.

The pupils then work in pairs to conduct a mock interview.

Consolidation / Plenary:

The pupils can then write up their reports.

Pupils share and discuss best practice.

Extension Activity

From the information gathered they can then decide on the headline for their report.
