The table below has a list of events. Below the table is a probability line. Decide where you think the events should go on the probability line. Mark the position with the letters A, B, C, etc.

Give a reason for each choice.

	Event	Reason
A	All rivers will dry up next week.	
B	The sun will shine tomorrow.	
C	You will buy some food today.	
D	You will eat some food today.	
E	You will buy some new shoes soon.	
F	Roll a dice and get a 6.	
G	Roll a dice and get a 2.	
H	Roll a dice and get an odd number.	

Write the events above on the probability scale below, taking care to put the events in the most appropriate position between 0 and 1.
