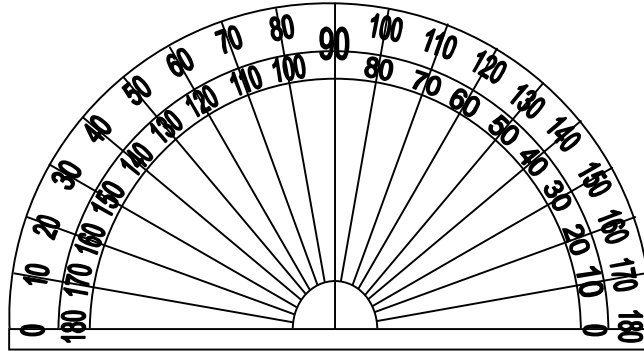
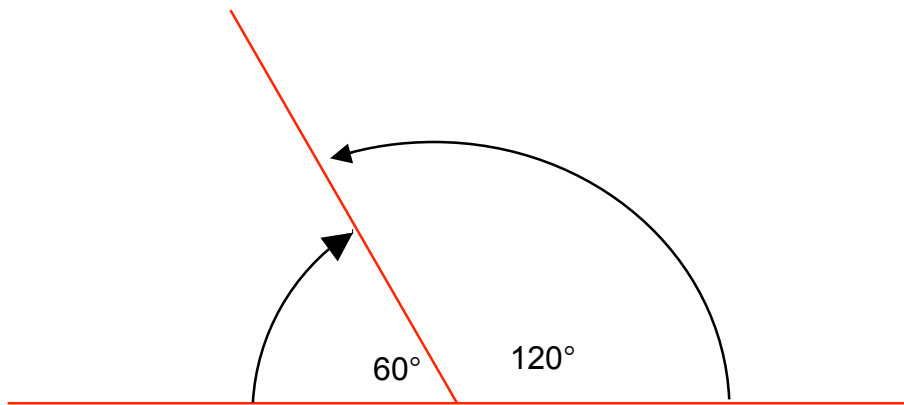


Measuring angles

A **protractor** is used to measure angles. It has two sets of numbers going in **opposite** directions.



Remember that **acute angles** are angles that are **less than 90°**. So to determine the size of the smaller angle, you read the outer number on the protractor if you're moving around clockwise.



To measure the smaller angle above, start from the 0° on the left and move around **clockwise**. It measures **60°**.

To measure the larger angle, start from 0° on the right and move around **anti-clockwise**. It measures **120°**.
