



Comparing data in lists



The data cards below provide information from two different countries - the UK and Burma.

What can you say about the countries by comparing these two data cards?

You can use the information to compare aspects of the two countries by sorting information into different categories, for example:

- **Area** - Burma is larger than the UK. Burma is 678,500 sq km and the UK is 244,820 sq km.
- **Population** - the UK has a larger population than Burma. The UK population is 60,609,153 and Burma's population is 42,720,196.
- **Religion** - the largest religious group in the UK is Christian; in Burma it's Buddhist.
