

## Finding information in a table 2

The table below shows the average temperature highs and lows in Jamaica (measured in degrees centigrade) during each month of the year.

Month of the year	Average highest temperature °C	Average lowest temperature °C
January	30	19
February	29	20
March	30	21
April	31	21
May	31	22
June	32	23
July	32	23
August	33	27
September	32	23
October	32	23
November	31	22
December	31	21

## Questions

- 1. Which months have an average temperature lower than 22°C?
- 1. Do any months have both the same average highest temperature and the same average lowest temperature as each other? Name the months and give the temperatures.
- 2. Which month or months have the smallest difference between their average highest and average lowest temperature? What is the difference in degrees centigrade?
- 3. Suggest the types of people who might be interested in the information in this table.
- 4. If you were shown the same information for the UK what differences would you expect to see?
