# Catch up on the Live lesson:

In case you missed it, catch up on the Live Lesson for the 2024/25 competition. Join presenters Joe Tasker and Shereen Cutkelvin, as they take your class on a journey inside a props warehouse, to discover how everyday objects can inspire epic stories.

## Activity sheet 1 - Inspiration from Everyday Objects:

Children are encouraged to choose an object around them and note it on the activity sheet. They then think about a character who owns the object and note why it's special, the character's name, and optionally, what their character looks like.

## Activity sheet 2: Interesting Characters:

On activity sheet 2 ask children to describe their character using a sentence with the word 'but'. Encourage pupils to think about their character's motivation and potential problems or conflicts their character might face.

## Activity Sheet 3 – Plot:

Children have one minute to start jotting down ideas as to what might happen at each step of their own story mountain.








## Beano
