

Tempo is measured in beats per minute (BPM). The pulse of the music controls the tempo. Italian words are often used to describe tempo. The tempo can change during a piece of music.

Italian accelerando (accel.) rallentando (rall.) ritardando (rit.) a tempo



Rhythm




Patterns of sounds that have different durations, played in time with the pulse




BBC Structure TEN **ØIECes** How a piece of music is organised (also called form) GET CREATIVE WITH CLASSICAL MUSIC Songs or pieces of music can be made up of contrasting musical sections. These different sections can be labelled (A, B, C etc) to help us understand the structure of a piece of music. In a song, the verse could be A and the chorus B.


