Top tips

For younger children


- Pull an item out of the bag and name it.

For older children

- Ask your child 'What's in the bag?'
 Without looking, can they find an item and describe how it feels.
- You can help them describe items by asking simple questions e.g. "is it big or small?"


Festive food matching game

How to play


Draw a line to match the fruits and vegetables that are the same. You could talk about each item e.g. "This one is red and round and this one is the same. They are both apples. They match!"




Match the fruits

How to play

Look at the picture of Duggee and help him get dressed. Talk about the items and where they go, e.g. "Boots go on his feet". Point to and draw a line to where each item of clothing goes on Duggee's body.





Top tips

- Talk about the type of winter clothes you wear when you go outdoors, what they feel like and where they go on your body.
- You could also count the items as you get dressed, e.g. two gloves, two fluffy socks, one hat and one big coat.
