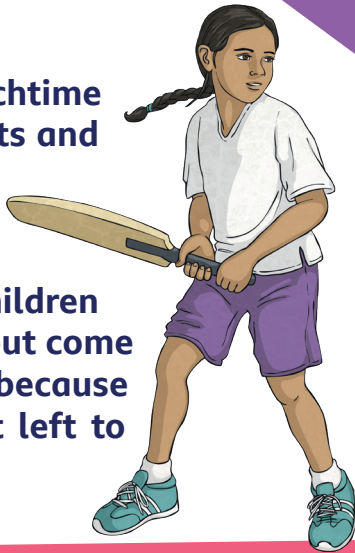

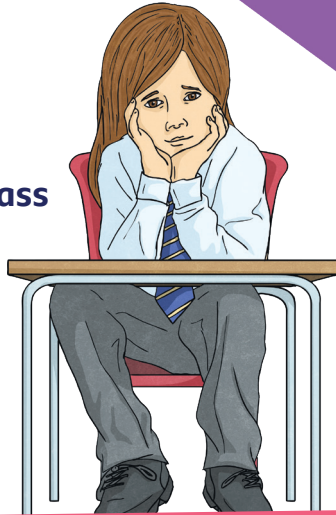
Your friend has shared a picture of their new shoes on a messaging app you use. Children in your group of friends can see the picture and you can all post a comment if you'd like to.
